Dear Hale'iwa Families,

Happy New Year! We hope that everyone enjoyed a safe and relaxing winter break.

As we return to school, we are very aware of the surge in COVID cases across the state over the last few weeks. As we have in the past, we are asking for all of our families to help us implement our core mitigating strategies. **Please continue to do "Daily Wellness Checks" every day.** Hale'iwa families have been OUTSTANDING in not sending your children to school if they have any COVID-like symptoms. We really appreciate your efforts in this area. At school, we continue to enforce consistent use of masks and hand washing with soap or the use of hand sanitizer as often as possible. If we continue to work together, we are hopeful that we can minimize COVID on our campus.

Yesterday afternoon, the HIDOE adopted the Hawaii DOH's recommended guidelines to reduce the quarantine time for confirmed positive cases from 10 days to 5 days. People who are identified as close contacts and are NOT vaccinated will also need to quarantine for 5 days.

Beginning this week, Hale'iwa is increasing our weekly COVID testing for students and staff to 3 days a week: Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 7:15 - 8:15am. Testing is conducted in our school cafeteria on the stage. It is self-administered by the child with a trained adult observing them to ensure it is done correctly.
